What is Red Ribbon
Month?

Red Ribbon Month was established to honor Enrique (“Kiki”) Camarena, a U.S. Drug Enforcement Agent who was kidnapped and murdered while investigating an illegal drug gang in Mexico. A year after the agent’s death, angry citizens in Kiki’s hometown in California responded by wearing red ribbons, showing their support for the war against illegal drugs.

We use the red ribbon as a symbol of our intolerance towards the use of drugs and the abuse of alcohol.


WHEREAS, the National Red Ribbon Campaign will be celebrated in every community in America during "Red Ribbon Week," October 23-31, 2013; and


WHEREAS, President Barack Obama and Mrs. Michelle Obama are the National Honorary Chair people to provide national focus on a Drug Free America; and



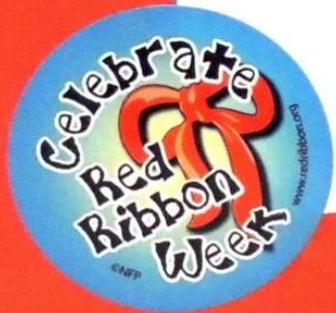
