WHEREAS, the Hillsborough Township Board of Education has certified to the Somerset County Board of Taxation a reduced 2010-2011 school tax levy in the amount of \$76,673,606 now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that before June 30, 2010 the Hillsborough Township Board of Education will discuss and determine modifications to the proposed 2010-2011 school budget and be it,

FURTHER RESOLVED, the Superintendent and Secretary file a revised 2010-2011 Annual School District Budget Statement prior to June 30, 2010 as required by law.
